

## FOUNDATIONS IN DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES: SW3060/7060

## Offered Fall 2018, Open to all disciplines

This course explores the lived experiences of individuals with developmental disabilities and their families. Students will become knowledgeable about practice areas for specialized expertise in developmental disabilities. Focus will be on community integration, ethical, legal and policy issues, theoretical models used in the disability field, medical aspects of disability, and best practice regarding social work support services and intervention strategies. This course will offer students opportunities to learn from professional and lay caregivers, individuals with developmental disabilities, and leaders and advocates in the field.

3 credit hour course. Meets each Monday from 1:00PM-3:50PM.
