

Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS)

Instruction in Self-Advocacy—4 hours

Who: Any student who is on an IEP, ETR or 504 and between the ages of 14-21 throughout Hamilton, Butler and Clermont counties. They can be eligible or potentially eligible for VR services. They do not need to have an open case with OOD.

What: Free, accessible, one-on-one services. Four 1-hour sessions of Self-Advocacy Instruction.

Instruction in Self-Advocacy will help students learn skills needed for greater independence.

When: During their school day or after school

Where: At their school or in the community

Why: These are introductory, foundational and skill-building services that are intended to help students with disabilities get a jump start on transition by learning how to communicate effectively, identifying appropriate and realistic career interests, starting to make successful decisions about their future and much more.



How: Parents, teachers or other school staff can fill out a “Request for Services” form and send in to OOD with proper documentation of disability (IEP/ETR/504). Services can start as soon as a referral is processed. Services will be provided within three months of a referral.
