Job Overview: Parent/primary caregiver who has first-hand experience accessing behavioral health services for their children. This role walks hand-in-hand with parents/families who are beginning to navigate family services and offers support and understanding as someone who has been there, done that. This position also coordinates parent groups and assists in informal networking to develop sustainable and understanding support systems for families.

## What is Family Peer Support?

Family Peer Support offers support to families with school age children experiencing behavioral difficulties or need support managing services or resources for their child or family. This partnership is provided through Talbert House and Beech Acres.

□ Physical Requirements: Frequent to occasional standing and walking. Frequent to constant sitting.
Frequent driving in accordance with job duties assigned. Rare climbing. Infrequent balancing, stooping,
kneeling, crouching, and crawling. Occasional reaching, handling, and fingering. Rare tasting/smelling
and use of color vision. Occasional use of midrange and far visual acuity, field of vision and depth
