- There will be no new shut-off orders.
- If you are currently disconnected, the Winter Reconnect order has been extended until <u>May 1st</u>
 – this allows you to pay \$175 to get services turned back on.

Cleveland Public Power

- There will be no new shut-off orders.
- If you are currently disconnected, you will be reconnected. If you have recently experienced a disconnection, you need to call CPP at 216-664-4600 to discuss restoring your service.

City of Cleveland Water

- There will be no new shut -off orders.
- If you are currently disconnected, you will be reconnected. If you have recently experienced a disconnection, you need to call Cleveland Water at 216-664-3131 to discuss restoring your service.

> Spectrum (Internet)

- For Ohio residents (who do not have a Spectrum broadband subscription already)
- Spectrum offers assistance to families that do not have internet at home:
 - Free broadband, including installation, from Spectrum for 60 days (after March 16th)
- Spectrum parent company, Charter, will offer assistance to households with K-12 and/or college students
 - Free broadband and Wi-Fi for 60 days (after March 16th)

Important Notice Regarding HEAP/PIPP, Winter Crisis and PRC Appointments!!

The health and well-being of our customers, staff, and communities are our highest priority. We understand the concern and uncertainty we are all experiencing surrounding the Coronavirus, therefore effective immediately, we will no longer be conducting Face-to-Face appointments for the Percentage of Income Payment Plan Plus (PIPP) and Winter Crisis.

What this means for households with currently scheduled appointments:

- Your appointment date/time is still valid, however instead of going into an agency, you will be called by a HEAP Intake Specialist on the same date/time as your original appointment.
- You will be instructed on how to submit required documentation during your phone interview.
- If the phone number you provided when originally scheduling your appointment is no longer valid and/or you did not provide a phone number, please immediately call 216-774-2362 to update your phone number.

If your household is not currently scheduled and needs an appointment:

- Appointments are available. Please call 216-350-8008 to schedule.
- Instead of going into an agency, you will be called by a HEAP Intake Specialist on the date and time of your appointment.
- You will be instructed on how to submit required documentation during your phone interview.
- To avoid appointment delays, the telephone number you provide when scheduling must be a working number and one that you may be reached at to conduct your telephone interview.

Unemployment

Ohio is expanding the state's unemployment insurance system to immediately cover workers who are displaced, even temporarily, by the coronavirus crisis.

The state will waive the typical waiting period required to qualify, and also will waive a requirement that people who get jobless benefits seek work

The emergency measure also will apply to workers who aren't offered paid leave through work, or who are under quarantine by their job or a health-care professional.

Anyone can apply for unemployment benefits online 24/7 or during business hours Monday through Friday, according to the Ohio Department of Jobs and Family Services.

How can I apply for unemployment benefits?

The quickest, easiest way to file for unemployment benefits is through the ODJFS website. Anyone who is eligible for benefits can <u>apply here</u>.

A printable, step-by-step guide to applying for unemployment benefits online <u>is available here</u>. You can also view <u>How-To Videos</u> for various aspects of applying for unemployment benefits.

You can also apply by phone Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m, by calling toll-free 1-877-644-6562 or TTY 1-614-387-8408.

If you don't have access to a computer, it's suggested you apply by phone to practice safe social distancing. But computers are available, free to the public, at OhioMeansJobs centers throughout Northeast Ohio. To find the closest center, <u>visit this website</u> or call 888-296-7541.

All loan applicants must:

• Live in Northeast Ohio.

• Have an income with the ability to repay the loan on a monthly basis.

• If married, apply with spouse/partner as co-applicant. A co-applicant may also be appropriate in other situations.

• Have been financially impacted by the current pandemic.

Other important things to know:

- Credit will be checked for all applicants and co-applicants with an emphasis on payment history, not a three digit score.
- ➤ The maximum loan amount is \$1,500.
- If you do not qualify for this emergency loan, or need more funds (up to \$10,000) you may be eligible to apply for our standard interest free loan with a guarantor.
