THAT ARE BLACK-OWNED.

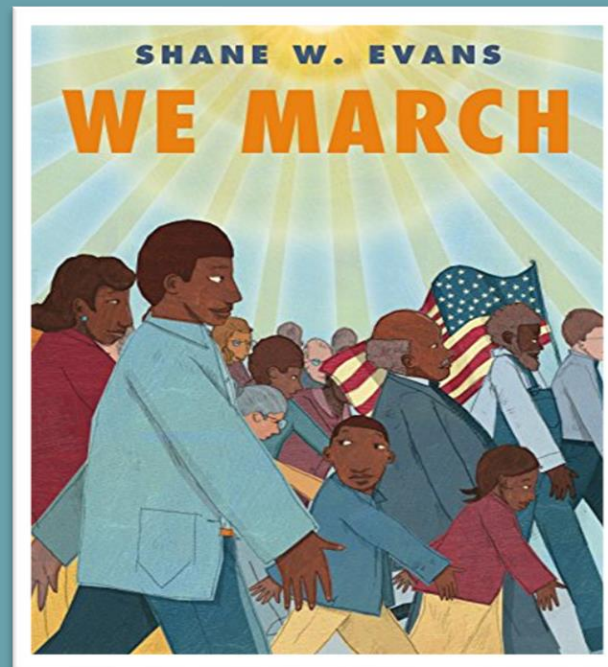
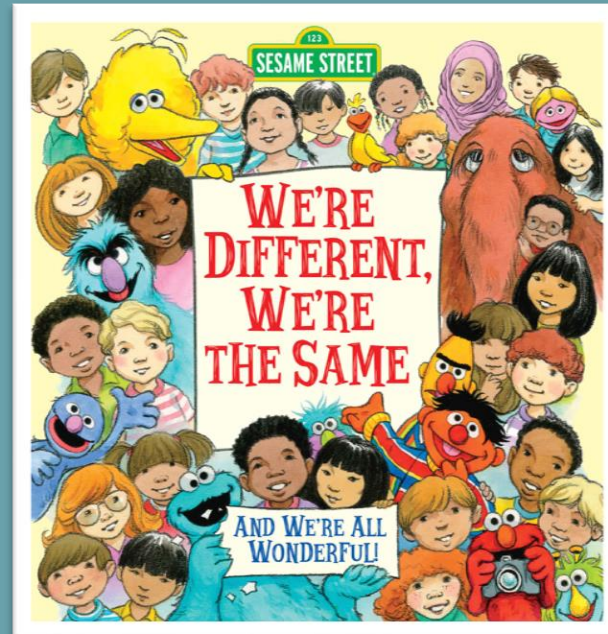
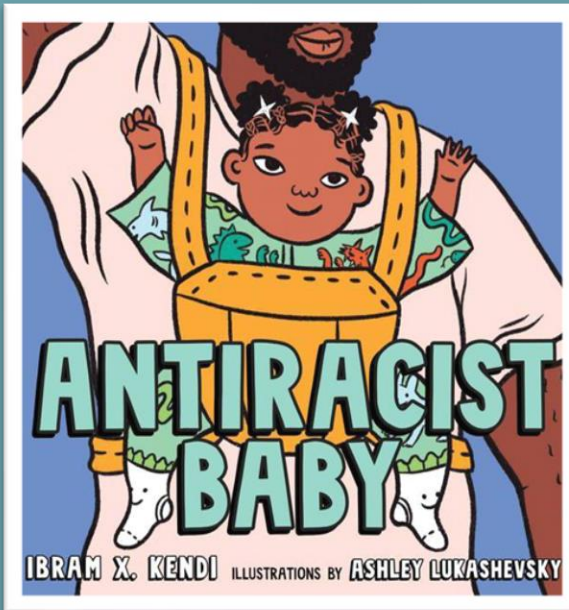


I CAN SHOW SUPPORT TOO. I
